# Bridge II Installation

It is important to check to see if the Bridge requires a firmware update on a monthly or quarterly basis. To do this you must be connected to the Internet. Once connected, go to the Input Select screen on the DAC's touch screen. On the Bridge input select bar, touch the green edit icon on the right hand side. This brings you to the Bridge setup page where you can touch the option to upgrade the firmware. Once upgrading DO NOT REMOVE POWER WHILE THE BRIDGE IS UPDATING.

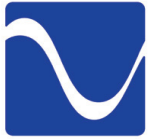

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## PerfectWave Bridge Installation Instructions

- 1 Turn off the DAC using the power switch on the rear of the unit.
- 2 Using a Phillips screwdriver (#1 tip), remove the two screws holding the blank panel over the expansion slot on the rear of the PerfectWave DAC. Retain the screws to hold the Bridge card in place later.
- 3 Follow the instructions on the bag of the disposable wrist strap included in the box. Connect the alligator clip to a suitable Earth ground.
- 4 Remove the PerfectWave Bridge printed circuit board assembly from the ESD bag.
- 5 Insert the Bridge card into the expansion slot. Slide the board in the rail guides. You will feel some resistance when the connector mates with the fingers on the front of the Bridge card. Press firmly until the surface of the Bridge card back panel contacts the back of the DAC.



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- 6 Reinstall the screws to hold the Bridge card in place.
- 7 You may now remove the wrist strap.

- 10 Connect an Ethernet cable from a network switch, router, or hub to the Ethernet port on the Bridge card back panel.
